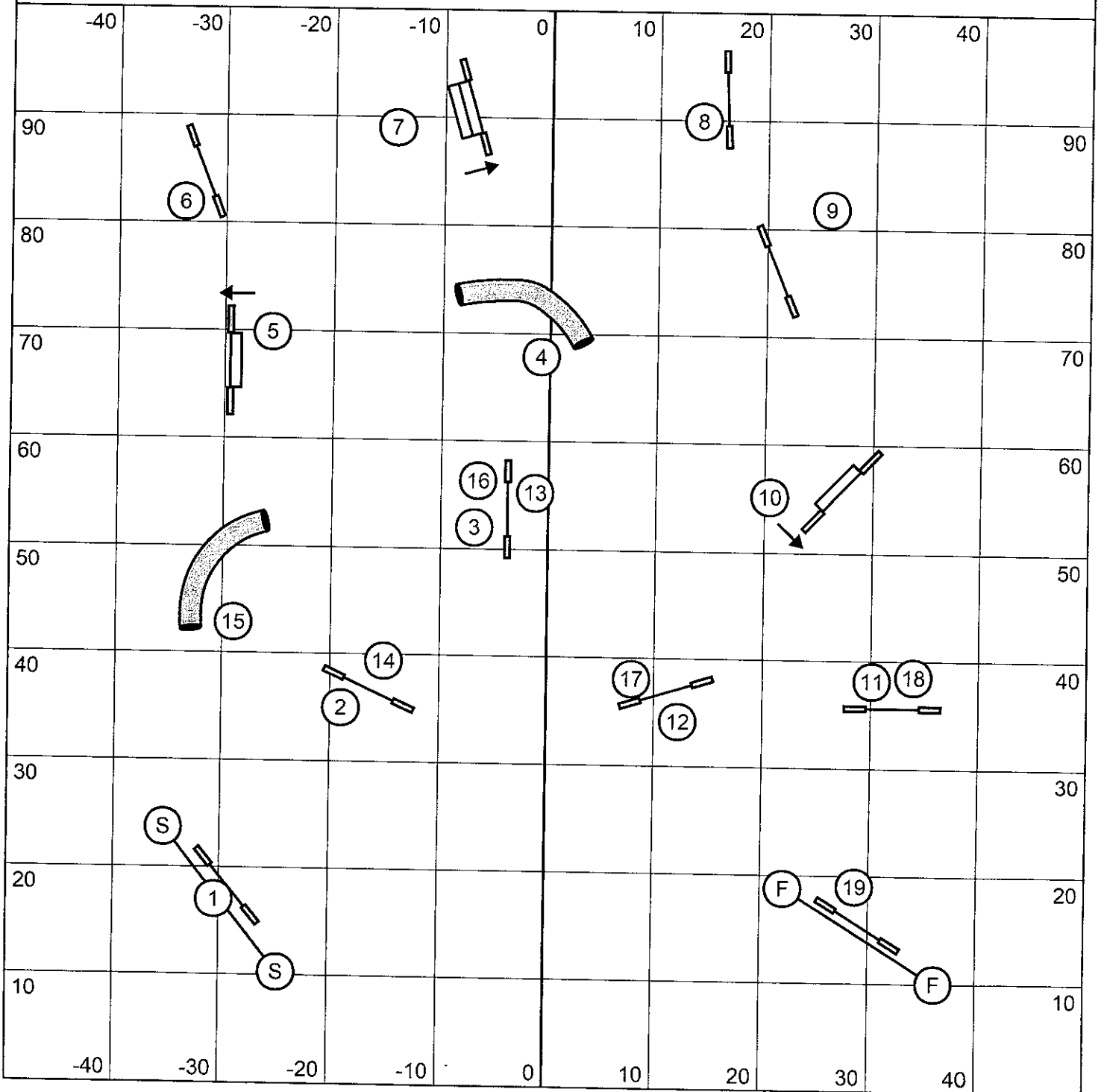
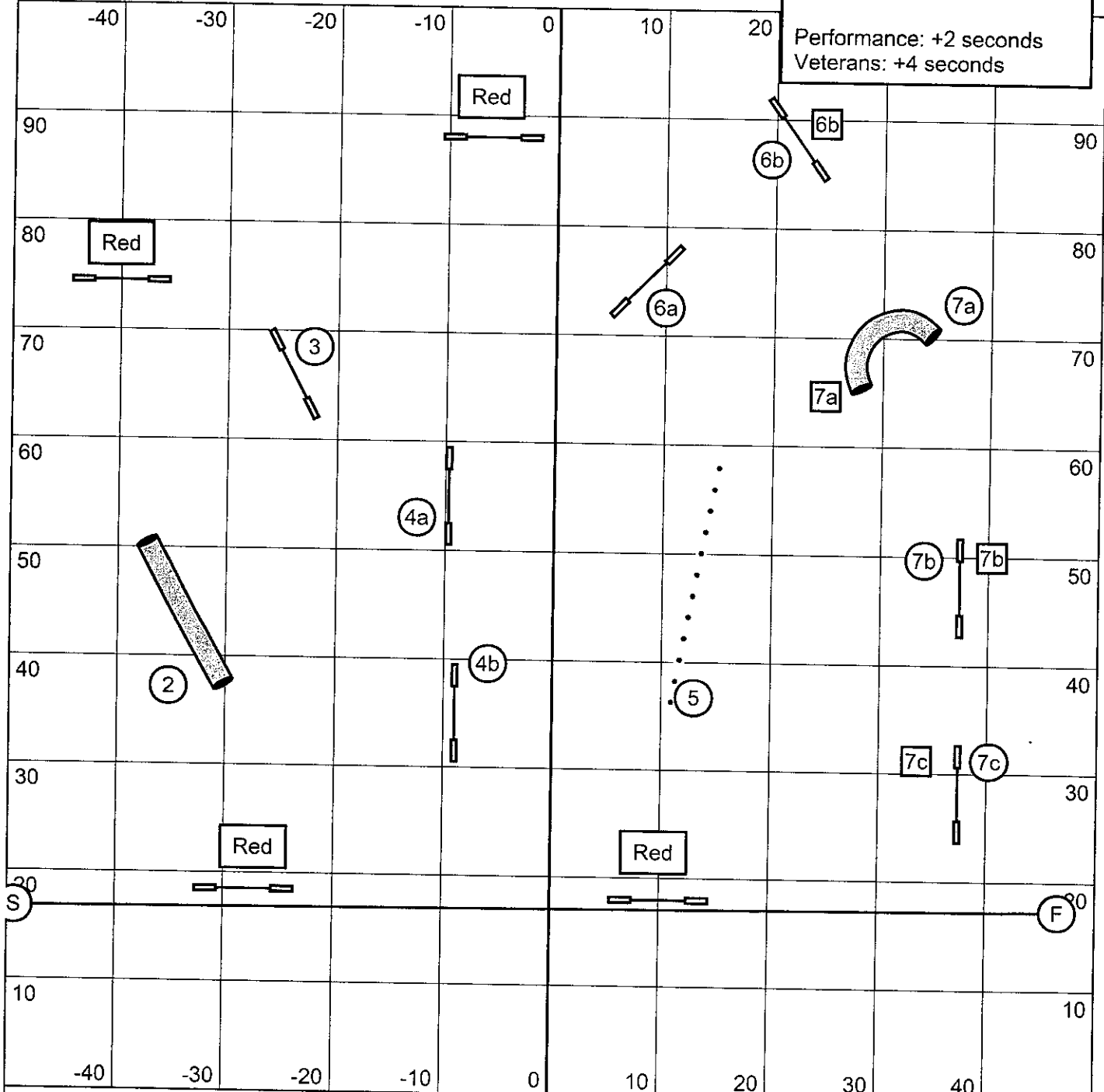

 Veterans: +4 seconds

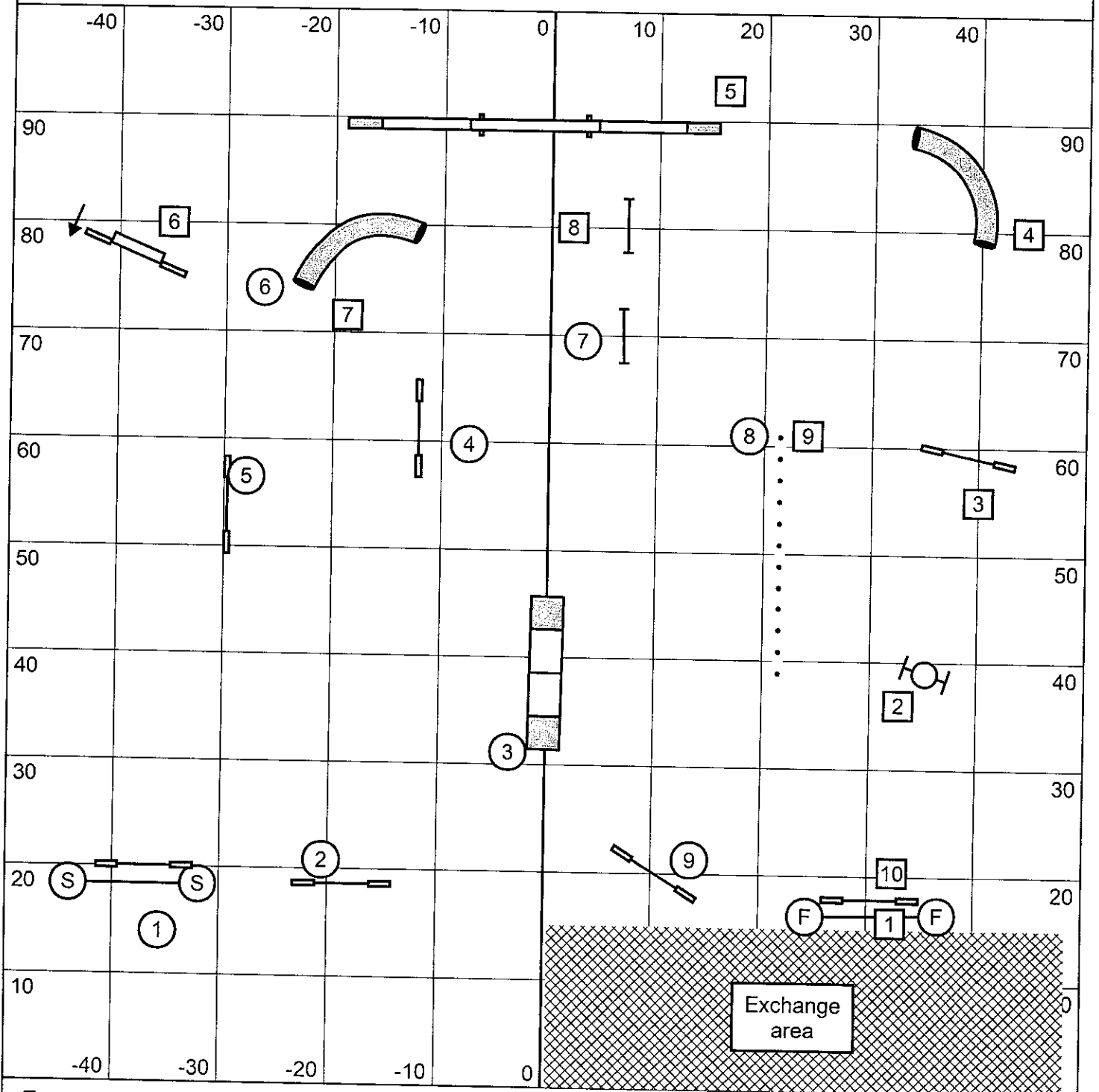


Can attempt either 3 or 4 reds

In the opening, all single obstacles are bi-directional.
 In the opening, all combinations #4a-b and/or #6a-b are bi-directional in direction and/or flow.
 In the opening, all combinations #7a-c must be taken as a, b, c, or c, b, a.

In the closing, all obstacles (including #2) must be taken in the direction specified.
 In the closing, the handler can choose either circle or square 6b; whatever choice is selected dictates if the 7a-c closing is circle or square. For example, square 6b means that the team must execute square 7a-c.

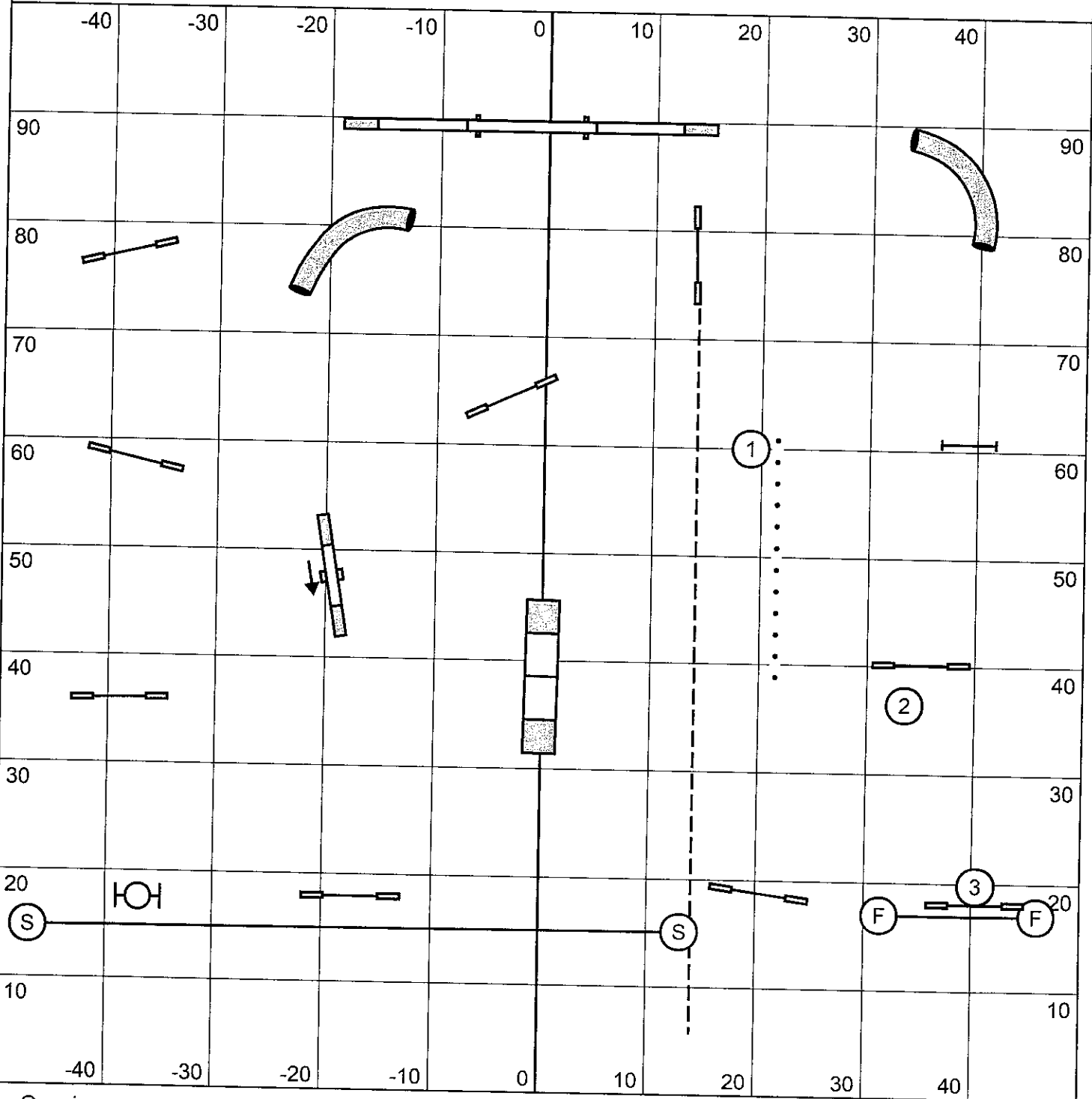
